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Introduction

The PDFs accessed through this site are lecture notes intended to help you more quickly learn the procedures in my course syllabi. I've created some conventions within the PDFs to make them easier to use and to speed up your study.

These lecture notes are intended to augment your study, and are not a substitute for constant work and practice. They can be an extremely useful tool as you practice complex concepts and procedures, and I will assume that you are practicing regularly outside of class as we move from one concept to the next.

Guidelines for use

- Individual PDFs are arranged in US-Letter sized pages to facilitate printing.
 - Each PDF is arranged with an introduction, then step-by-steps if applicable.
 - Always check the last page of each PDF -- Assignments and deadlines will be listed there.
 - Text that refers to specific software tools, dialogs, functions, or commands (and are therefore likely to be in the software's help-files) are underscored and hilited in red.
 - Text that refers to object names, especially in 3D, are underscored and hilited in blue when instructions call for initially naming the object. The blue-hilite will appear only when the object is initially created and named in the procedure.
 - CAUTIONS are underscored or CAPITALIZED, or BOTH, but remain in black.
 - If there are additional files that accompany an exercise, you will find them in the "Shared" folder of the appropriate DTEC server-folder for your course.
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
